INTRODUCTION

After the global COVID-19 pandemic, the vulnerability of already affected communities increased and there was a stepback regarding the advance of women, youths, and emerging leaders, through economic, entrepreneurship, and business development initiatives. Therefore, Casa Foundation works on developing resources and events to offer support to vertical sectors in the area of health, infrastructure, and education. The following document includes a general summary of one of the most important annual events of CASA Foundation, Friends of Africa 2022–Economic Summit.

Executive Summary

Thanks to all the supporters of Casa Foundation, another Friends of Africa (FOA) Economic Summit successfully took place on October 12 – 15, 2022. Global leaders and experts gathered virtually and physically to share ideas on how to improve the economies of communities globally.

FOA - Where Ideas Meet Opportunities

Casa Foundation hosted its 12th Edition of the Friends of Africa (FOA) Economic Summit on the 12th -15th of October with the aim of facilitating wealth-creating ideas for the development of African economies and diasporan businesses. FOA has evolved to become the anchor program for connecting professionals, businesses, and entrepreneurs with public, private, and investment communities globally.

FOA - Theme

Following the remarkable success of previous Friends of Africa (FOA) Economic Summit, its 12th edition provides a unique experience which connects global influencers and leaders from the academia, government, private sector, and industry to explore the theme: "Unlocking Resources for Global Recovery".

The pandemic adversely impacted the world and strained institutions and economies globally. Due to this, Africa, particularly, could suffer revenue losses of US\$650 billion (UNCTAD 2021). As countries reopen their economies and ease restrictions, a long-term recovery plan built on partnerships, allegiance, and capital creation through platforms like AFCTA, APFTA, and other Country Free Trade Areas may accelerate recoveries, particularly in emerging markets and Sub-Saharan Africa. Achieving global recovery by building resilient economies is critical for the long-term expansion of African economies post COVID-19.

FOA - Event Format

The 12th annual FOA Economic Summit was a hybrid event with both in-person and virtual experiences. Participants convened virtually on October 12th -13th for online pitch presentations, and physically from October 14th -15th for summit sessions. The FOA Marketplace, which was offered on-site for small enterprises, was another highlight of the economic summit. Local delegates concluded the conference on October 15, 2022, the last day, with an evening networking session, and a dinner gathering.


FOA 2022: "Unlocking Resources for Global Recovery"

FOA DAY 1: OCT 12TH-ONLINE

FOA 2022 started with the Mock Pilot of the Welcome to Pitch Masters: For Entrepreneurs, in which the Pitch Masters prepared for 50 SMEs participating for the SME Grants of \$5000.00, sponsored by TD Bank. The first day of the conference was held virtually and featured by pitch participants of the EP Academy. The presentations were made in front of a panel of judges.

FOA DAY 2: OCT 13TH-ONLINE

The second day of the event held the actual Welcome to Pitch Masters: For Entrepreneurs, in which 11 contestants did their Virtual Presentation in front of 7 judges. Participants heard from keynote speakers and various panelists who imparted powerful insights on the tools required for economic recovery and entrepreneurship.









FOA DAY 3: OCT 14TH-IN-PERSON

The third day of the conference held the Welcome to Job Fair: For Youths & Professionals at the Westin Harbor Castle Hotel, Downtown Toronto at the Dockside Meeting Hall. Attendees and entrepreneurs were involved in dynamic discussions with two great speakers on topics related to personal branding and mental health.

During the second day, the conference also held the in-person Welcome to Pitch Masters: For Entrepreneurs (Actual) session with 9 participants.

The presentations were made in front of a panel of 5 judges. And lastly, in the evening was held the Networking session, in which entrepreneurs, speakers, attendees, influencers and judges were able to connect and network with personalities with outstanding backgrounds.



FOA DAY 4: OCT 15TH-IN-PERSON

On the last day of the Economic Summit, the conference started with a marketplace event showcasing products by Black business owners, followed with an opening breakfast at the Westin Harbor Castle Hotel, Downtown Toronto. Followed by the Welcome Remarks by Dr. Olutoyin Oyelade, President of Casa Foundation & Partner InVcap. The Grand Finale of the conference featured 4 Discussion Panels with outstanding leaders of different African countries and Canada. The topics discussed in the panels were:





DISCUSSION PANEL 1: LEARNING DIGITALLY: BUILDING AN EFFECTIVE DIGITAL EDUCATION SYSTEM BEYOND 2025.

The panel was moderated by the Prof. Wendy Cukier and the panelist involved were Prof. Vida Shehada and Prof. Sandrine Prom Tep. In this panel the speakers discussed the challenges that academic institutions and students face with digital learning, as well as which could be some initiatives that set out a common vision of high-quality.

DISCUSSION PANEL 2: UNLOCKING RESOURCES FOR GLOBAL RECOVERY FOR RETAIL AND CORPORATE MARKETS THROUGH ECOMMERCE.

The Panel was moderated by Prof. Nancy Adossi, the panelists involved in the discussion were Idas Levato, Charles Wright, and Cheryl Bedard, who talked about the importance of the resources available for entrepreneurs and how nowadays the corporate markets through e-commerce and empowerment.





ROUND-TABLE DISCUSSION 3: PUBLIC SECTOR POLICIES FOR GLOBAL RECOVERY ACROSS BORDER.

She graduated from the University of Quebec in Montreal and the State University of Stony-Brook in New York. She has a master's degree in Business Administration, and a double major in Sociology.

Hosted by Dino Onyenokwe, this years' Pitch Masters competition was held virtually and inperson. Viewers were treated to heart-pounding presentations by participants from the EP Academy, Black Advisory Hub and CASA Labs.

BRIEF STORY

Dr. Olutoyin Olyelade, President of Casa Foundation, opened the Pitch Masters session with a special welcome to the judges and contestants, and an overview of the Pitch Masters' program. The Pitch Masters' program was created by Casa Foundation in 2015 with the aim of connecting groups of start-ups, young entrepreneurs and aspiring entrepreneurs to meet with like minded individuals and groups that are looking to fund and provide capital to them for their own business venture.

Since the inception of the Pitch Masters program in 2015, over 165 pitch candidates have pitched their business ideas to various judges and investors. To-date, over \$100,000 has been awarded in pitch grant awards. 
